Getting Bogged Down for Wildlife

How far would you go for wildlife? How about 12 miles... through mud... and freezing cold water... over really steep hills. That's about as far as two of Cheshire Wildlife Trust's overenthusiastic bog-lovers are willing to go. In order to raise money to help with the restoration of Delamere's rare mossland habitats Katie Piercy, Delamere's Mossland Officer, and Vicky Nall, a local dragonfly expert, are taking part in the Delamere Hellrunner race, which itself passes through several of the bogs the money will go towards restoring.

The Hellrunner race takes place on the 1st November 2014 and is a more of a mud bath than a trail run. Racers must pass through the bog of doom, an area of muddy water which in places reaches over 2m in depth. Other challenges include the hills of hell, steep muddy slopes which will certainly be much quicker to come down than go up.

So why take part in such a gruelling endeavour? The Delamere's mosses are an amazing network of wildlife sites ranging from wet heathland to mossland habitats. If you've ever had the opportunity to watch the iridescent green hairstreak flutter amongst the bilberry bushes in early spring, or been lucky enough to spot a white-faced darter dragonfly resting amongst the rushes, reintroduced to its native home after a ten years absence, then you will understand the value of these rare and unusual habitats.

Frodsham Neighbourhood Plan

Chairman of Frodsham Town Council, Mark Warren, reported that they had agreed to carry out a Neighbourhood Plan and a steering group meeting to get the process underway would be held shortly. He said that being a neighbouring parish, we would need to be consulted as the plan progressed. The Parish Council agreed to assist where possible and respond to any consultations in due course. November 2014

The centenary anniversary of the First World War

The staff and pupils have been paying special commemorations to the 100 year anniversary of the First World War.

The whole school have had a cross curricular research focus on the first world war. The children have studied and written poetry, written descriptions of a range of settings and letters home from the trenches. They have researched the countries involved in the conflict and the reasons why the first world war escalated into war.

Earlier in the term, the pupils had an experience session with a local actor, who came into school to share stories of life in the trenches.



Following this, the children visited Dunham Massey, and the Stamford Military Hospital.



The half term will end this week with a World War One tea room in the school hall. Each class have investigated WW1 recipes and designed adaptations to them for the modern age. Their culinary and design results will be available to purchase at the WW1 tea rooms on Thursday 23rd October at 2.00pm. There will be a collection for Help For Heroes on that day also.

New OPAL Club for isolated Elderly People coming soon to Frodsham

Rural Community Services (West Cheshire) is planning to open a new OPAL Club in Frodsham. We are aware that as people get older, they find it more and more difficult to get out and about to meet friends, and this is where our OPAL Clubs come in.

We currently run 5 well supported clubs across Cheshire, and want to do the same in Frodsham. Our clubs are designed for elderly people living in the community who are at risk of social isolation. We operate 1 or 2 days a week from 10am-3pm and provide a hot mid-day meal, activities, trips, transport and support. We can have between 12-20 regular members and we ask members to contribute £10 a day towards running costs.

The Clubs are run largely by volunteers, with the support of a paid member of staff, therefore we urgently need new volunteers to come forward and help us get established in Frodsham.

We are looking for local people to help us in the following ways:

- General helpers on the day

- Key volunteers to lead sessions and activities

- Cooks

- Drivers to offer transport

- Committee Members

Full training will be given and expenses paid.

There was a five mile walk on 24 September from Great Budworth, followed by an enjoyable lunch at the George & Dragon.

On 14 October eight of us enjoyed a 7.5 mile walk from Potts Shrigley. Starting from near to the West Gate of Lyme Park, we climbed steadily over moorland to the Bowstones, meeting the Gritstone Trail, and enjoying views to the north, west and east. We then headed northwards, downhill, eventually crossing the eastern approach to the Park. We continued northward, passing the Bollinhurst Reservoirs, to arrive at the north gate to the Park.
