Insulation Campaign

- Heather took the group through the newly worded Energy Saving Trust (EST) letter offering advice to people of the village on insulation and also explained that the Community Centre is booked for an EST event promoting insulation on 7th June 2010 between 6pm and 8pm.
- Simon apologised for not forwarding the letter to other members of the group as he, rather embarrassingly, thought he had.
- Simon to add event time and date to village web site, Facebook group and to email the KTI database.

Solid Wall Insulation

- Heather has asked the EST management to find out why no reply has been received to recent communication. Allan will forward any information received from them.

Renewable Energy

- Allan Arthur has done a case study of a solar PV installation in Ball lane and will forward to Simon for inclusion on web site.
- Allan to agree date with Roy Griffiths for doing a case study on his solar thermal installation.
- Allan stated that Simon Batey prepared to give talk about his solar PV installation at the event planned for 9 October 2010.
- Allan is keen to talk to the KCA with regards the possibility of solar on the Community Centre roof.
- Heather is going to forward details about Bickerton Community Centre, who have also installed solar panels.
- Heather and Allan stated that they had looked into the average wind speed in Kingsley and found it only just good enough for wind power so probably a hard avenue to follow.
- Allan to get recommendation on energy meters (with a possibility of one available for EON customers).

- Simon Batey has agreed to give a presentation and answer questions on his new POV installation.
- KTI to report on what they have achieved so far, with plans for the future.

- EST can support 9 October event and Allan is to meet them in November as part of a regular get together.
