Kingsley Transition Initiative (KTI) would like to thank everybody for all their support throughout 2010: We had an eventful year that concluded on 11<sup>th</sup> December with a very successful market comprising of 20 stalls, the bell ringers of St John's school and the band of Kingsley Community school. Thank you everybody who attended and took part.

We would also like to thank Kingsley residents for their great support of our other projects and to wish you all a very happy (and increasingly sustainable) 2011.

In 2010 we had a range of achievements including:

- 4 successful Local Produce Markets
- The obtaining of planning permission, with conditions, for 17 allotments.
- A lively energy group encouraging Kingsley residents both to insulate their homes and to adopt renewable energy. So far there is one PV solar installation in the village with 2 others ordered, as well as two solar hot water systems currently in operation.
- A 'sustainability' event in October with talks ranging from bee keeping, managing
  allotments, herbal medicine, cycling and policing in the community. This event was
  sponsored by Reaseheath college, with whom we have since fostered a close working
  relationship.

Our plans for 2011 include:

- 4 more Local Produce Markets on the following dates:
  - 12<sup>th</sup> March,
  - 11<sup>th</sup> June,
  - 10<sup>th</sup> September
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> December
- To get our allotments up and running
- To further our energy projects including PV solar panels on the roof of the Community centre
- To further develop our relationships with our schools, churches and with Reaseheath college.
- To contribute to the Kingsley Parish plan

#### KINGSLEY WALKING GROUP

On 24th November in bright sunshine that belied the cold weather, 24 walkers set off from the Plough Inn, Whitegate, across the fields, and walked along the side of a valley through frosted trees to a little fishing lake near Foxtwist Farm. Following Bogart Brook and then a broad track to eventually cross the road and Whitegate Way at Martonsands. A coffee break was taken at Marton Hole, before climbing past Marton Green Farm, which provided a good view over the Cheshire Plain. After rejoining the Whitegate Way, we passed Homes owned by footballers who play for Northern clubs. Leaving the Whitegate Way we walked round the lake at Newchurch Common and followed the lanes until we reached Cassia Green and then back to the Plough for a good lunch.

The combined Christmas walk on 14 December was a circular of approx 5.5 miles from the Tiger's Head. We headed off through Home Farm then across to Beech Lane, before crossing Norley Road and taking the footpath to Flaxmere, thence via Delamere Way for a short loop in the forest before returning to Norley via Gallowsclough Lane. The weather was relatively mild and dry. Back at the Tiger's Head the 24 walkers were joined by two others for an excellent traditional Christmas lunch.

Kingsley Walking Group have two walks each month, meeting at the Community Centre at 9.30am. On the second Tuesday there is a long walk, bring a packed lunch.
