The Garden Club Committee met in early January, to plan the September 2020 to June 2021 programme, and we can confirm that there are some very exciting speakers so far lined up. I don't think it would be breaking the Official Secrets Act to say we are due to have a speaker from the new RHS Bridgewater Garden speaking to us later this year. The Committee is always open to suggestions for speakers and / or topics, if you have any ideas please speak to a committee member. Things to do in the garden in February....

- Prepare vegetable beds and sow early seeds but protect with cloches
- Start chitting Early potato tubers ready to plant out at the end of the month
- Prune any winter flowering shrubs that have finished flowering.
- Prune Wisteria cutting back summer growth to 2 or 3 buds.
- Cut back ornamental grasses down to a few inches from the ground before new growth.
- Now is the time to move deciduous shrubs that you want to reposition.

VE Day 75

The weekend of 8th - 10th May 2020, is fast approaching and as a Parish Council, we want to facilitate those residents who wish to mark this memorable date to be able to do so in a way that will involve the whole of the village community. We asked via Kingsley News and Social Media for ideas from residents as to how best to mark the occasion. We have had a suggestion for a street party on Top Road, we have had offers from people wishing to come and give talks on the period.

The Parish Council is proposing that the Kingsley Playing Field (soon to be renamed Kingsley Park) would be used to host all the planned events. To this end, it is proposed that there is an informal meeting on **Wednesday 12th February 2020, in The Red Bull from 7pm**, to discuss any suggestions that people may have for the day. Representatives from the Parish Council will be on hand. This will be an informal chat and should not last more than an hour.

Suggestions for topics to be discussed may be; which day do we choose to celebrate the event over the three day weekend. Is the event themed to 1945; what events should be put on; are local groups going to be involved (cubs, Scouts, Brownies, Guides, KYG, Kingsley Youth Theatre)? Without help from members of the village community, nothing will happen and the event will go unmarked in Kingsley. What a shame that would be.

Kingsley Walking Group – January 2020



The long walk in January was planned to be from the Macclesfield Forest to Shutlingsloe, the Cat and Fiddle and back. A careful recce confirmed that the route was not affected by mud, which was a relief after several weeks of rain. Unfortunately, the weather on the day was poor. Despite this, a hardy group of 12 people set off in the wind and rain. At the top of Shutlingsloe a car-full left the main group and headed for home. The “crazy 7” carried on, missing out the Cat and Fiddle and returning to the forest. The rain stopped as we reached the cars. Well done to everyone for keeping cheerful as we wandered about in the rain. The January short walk on the 28th will be around Frodsham hill.

Our next **long walk is on February 11th**. Meet at the Community Centre ready to **leave at 9.30** and bring lunch. The **short walk will be on Tuesday 25th of February**, leaving the Community Centre at 9.30.

The Kingsley Walking group is an informal walking group that has been meeting for many years. We organise two walks each month. A long walk is held on the **SECOND** Tuesday of the month and a short walk is held on the **FOURTH** Tuesday of the month. Generally long walks would be classified as “moderate” (a full day and 8 – 10 miles) and the short walks are leisurely (a half day and up to 5 miles) ending with an optional pub lunch.

Long walks usually start up to 90 minutes drive away from Kingsley. We meet at the Community Centre and organise lifts and car shares. We have a leader for every walk who checks for stiles, distance, closed paths etc in advance. Our favourite places are the Peak District, the Clwyds and the south Lakes. Our groups are between 8 and 15 people. Everyone is welcome.

Long walks leave at 9am (except for January and February) and short walks leave at 9.30am ending at around 1pm with an optional pub lunch.
