Kingsley Parish Council Meeting 21 March 2017

Members of the Public One member of the public attended the meeting.

Planning applications. Playing Field. Treefellers Ltd will be carrying out necessary maintenance work on 26 March 2017. Unfortunately, during the recent storm, one tree which was due for maintenance fell onto the garden room of a property adjoining the playing field, this was removed the same day by Treefellers. Work has been carried out on the lights but one light needs further repair. Suggestions of how to accommodate both dog walkers who like to allow their dogs to run free and other users of the playing field were considered at the meeting and further consideration will take place at the next council meeting in order to make some decisions.

Cemetery. The Boardroom (the building inside the entrance to the cemetery) is to have a new floor on 1 May 2017 and will be painted both inside and outside. Two plans for creating a new cremation area for plots in the Extension of the Cemetery and also improving the area around the War Memorial will be discussed further by Council at the next meeting.

Community Fund Applications Council is in the process of informing those groups who have applied for grants, of the decision made by Council. The successful applicants will be invited to receive their cheques at the April Council meeting - 18 April.

Defibrillators A defibrillator has now been installed on the outside of the Kingsley & Newton Village Institute. The second one will be installed on the outside of the Pharmacy shortly. Council would like to record their thanks to Ben Turner the electrician at Cheshire Boiler & Electrical Services for offering his services free and also to Hayley & Baz of Cube Lighting who installed the defibrillator at KNVI for free, very generous. Many thanks also go to the pharmacist Mark, for allowing the defibrillator to be installed on the wall of the Pharmacy. Training on the use of the defibrillators and CPR will be arranged by the Council within the next few months. This training will be open to everyone who would like to attend and will be well advertised within the village.

Annual Parish Meeting The APM took place immediately after the main council meeting and reports from the Chairman, Financial Officer, and other councillors with dedicated responsibilities were read out. These reports are included in the APM Minutes which will be placed on the village website in due course.

PLEASE NOTE that the Minutes of the Parish Council's meetings are placed on the village website each month.

Kingsley Bookworms – Next meeting 6th April 2017 at the Red Bull at 7.30

Our March meeting was very busy. Our "book of the month" was My Husband's Wife by Jane Corry. In addition to this we had also decided to read the Costa shortlisted books to see how our opinions lined up with the judges'.

"My Husband's Wife" quite well received although the average score was 2.9, a lot lower than other books. While we thought it was an easy read, we felt that there were too many coincidences to be believable. The atmosphere created by the book was sinister.

The reason for reading the Costa books was that, in the past, we had been critical of prize winning books and we wanted to sample shortlisted books. The four books were Days Without End by Sebastian Barry (the winner), This Must Be the Place by Maggie O'Farrell, The Essex Serpent by Sarah Perry and The Gustav Sonata by Rose Tremain. During our discussion we agreed that there was a significant difference in the writing between My Husband's Wife and these books. This, in turn, tends to lead to better "book club" conversations.

At our April meeting we will be talking about "Birds without Wings" by Louis de Bernieres, an author that we have read before. In May we will be talking about The Vance Legacy by R Haywood Glen. The book is set in the southern United States, against a backdrop of slavery and life on a tobacco plantation. A full list of our books for 2017 is on our Facebook page.

The Mid-Cheshire 5k returns to Kingsley on Friday 28th April starting at 7.15pm. This staging of the race will also incorporate the England Athletics 5k Road Running Championships with some of the country's best athletes coming to the village. There will be some disruption from 7.00pm until approximately 8.00pm in the Ball Lane, Mill Lane and Crewood Common Road areas due to the course being closed to traffic. Spectators are invited to Kingsley Cricket club to see the start of the race or to Gibson's Mill Café which is the 1km point as well as being close to the finish area. The organisers have asked that locals coming to watch attend on foot. Race Director Mike Harrington said "As it's not a school night we would love to see as many accompanied children attending as possible, preferably with drums, tambourines and cowbells to create a fantastic atmosphere for the runners approaching the finish on Mill Lane". An original take on this classic story and it was good to see such a large cast work so well together. FRIENDS' 2017-2018 RENEWAL NOTICE

Our payment structure for the Financial Year 2017/18 is as follows :

Those who wish to use the facilities of the Institute shall become Friends of the Institute by making a donation of £15. This payment is asked for as a contribution to the Institute to consolidate the financial position whilst the Management Committee improves the facilities and the fabric of the building. We stress that the Committee will use its discretion for any known cases of hardship.

Tennis & Bowls : to be an Adult/Adult Family member of the KNVI Bowls and Tennis sections you must be a Friend of KNVI.

Membership of Bowls and Tennis : the following list of charges applies to both Bowls and Tennis, one payment will enable you to play either tennis or bowls **or both**. This is a significant change in the membership structure. Persons becoming members must register their interest for either bowls or tennis or both and must agree to abide by the rules and playing etiquette of both disciplines. Each section will be managed by a working committee which will be responsible to the KNVI Management Committee.

- Fees :**
- Adult membership £20 annually
 - Junior membership (under 18 yrs) £10 annually
 - Family membership £45 annually
 - Pay to Play : £2.50 per time for both tennis and bowls
 - Student membership (for all those in full time education) : £10

Please note : Junior membership does not stand alone, a parent/guardian must also become a Friend of the Institute

Guests : Bowls and tennis members will be entitled to take a guest with them free of charge to use the sports facilities, limited to three occasions annually for the same guest ,after which time the guest will be asked to comply with one of the above memberships.

Tuition : Any Friend of KNVI will be permitted to use the bowling green and tennis courts for tuition arranged by the bowling and tennis sections for a limited time to establish whether they wish to pursue the activity.

Friends' Children : Any child whose parent/s is /are Friends of KNVI may join in any activity of KNVI. **With respect to bowls and tennis**, Friends must be members of one of these sections for their child(ren) to qualify. This is designed to allow children to play the sport **with their parents**. If the child wishes to use the facilities otherwise then he/she must become a Junior member of the relevant section.

Other activities take place at the Institute on a regular basis : Line Dancing, Indoor Bowls, Snooker, Quiz Nights, Tai-Chi, Spanish Language Classes. Please contact any member of the Management Committee for further details.

Kingsley & Newton Village Institute is a registered charity providing a Village Hall and other facilities primarily for the people of Kingsley and Newton, but also for others. The support scheme "Friends of KNVI", launched by the KNVI Management Committee in 2015 has helped restore the financial viability of the Village Institute and has generated new interest in the Institute's facilities. You, as a Friend of KNVI, would play a vital role in conserving what is a wonderful asset for the community. An added bonus is that, as a registered charity, additional income is available for the Institute through Gift Aid if you are a taxpayer. **This only applies to your Friends' donation and not the Sports Membership**. In 2016-2017 we have been able to reclaim nearly £500 through this scheme. **We sincerely hope that you will support us in this way as we move forward.**
