## Kingsley Garden Club - July / August 2019

As you will no doubt be aware, Kingsley Garden Club did not have a meeting in June this year. It has been historical that we finish our season in May with an AGM, but In the past few years, we have combined the AGM with a visiting speaker. At a recent committee meeting, it was decided to extend the 2019/20 season to include June with a speaker and the AGM. In line with most other clubs and organisations, we do not have a meeting in July or August due to the main holiday season. **Our next meeting is 9th September 2019**, when William Woods from Blackbrook Nurseries will talk about the medicinal and culinary use of herbs. Most people have some herbs in their garden be it mint, chives, Rosemary, etc;. It will be interesting to learn what other herbs we can use safely and beneficially.

Well the weather has taken a very unseasonal turn for the worst in June, but by the time you read this, we will hopefully have said goodbye to the deluges and will be basking in nice warm sunshine! The herbaceous and other tall plants have suffered with the heavy downpours and will require supporting. Our lawns are now sodden and growing by the day, but do not be tempted to mow the lawn whilst heavy and wet, wait until they dry out and keep your blades reasonably high, do not scalp the lawn.

### Gardening Tips and Jobs to be done....

- Thin out the fruit on your trees such as apples, so you get better quality fruit & less susceptible to disease.
- Take cuttings from your favourite perennials.
- Support tall plants and climbers, important if we get high winds or more heavy rain.
- Remember to water your plants in pots, these dry easily with evaporation.
- Dead head all perennials and bedding plants to ensure continuous flowering throughout the season (roses really benefit from this)
- Cutting back growth in hanging baskets can encourage new flowers and tidy up the basket.
- Prune whippy shoots off Wisteria main branches to about five leaves from the main branch.
- Cut sweat peas for the vase on a regular basis and deadhead to ensure continuous flowering. Water regularly, these are very thirsty plants.
- If you are growing tomato's, remember to keep taking out side shoots. Take out the growing tip after five fruiting trusses. Feed tomato's regularly with Tomorite or similar.

On Saturday 15th June 11 of the litter pick team were joined by a mother and her 3 children (pupils at Saint John's School).


Altogether the 15 of us collected 15 bags of litter. As usual most of this was on the main roads through the village.

#### **Kingsley Bookworms**

#### Next meeting 11th July 2019 at the Hurst Chapel at 7.30pm

At our June meeting we talked about "I Am, I Am, I Am; Seventeen Brushes with Death" by Maggie O'Farrell. She's a favourite author of our group but this book is autobiographical and so very different to her normal novels. Most people agreed that it was well written but, the nature if the book meant that there was no character development or continuity which we missed. We also noted that the book's time jumped about which many people don't particularly like. The score was 2.5 out of 5, although most people were pleased to have read the book.

Our next book is "Reservoir 13" by Jon McGregor. The book was the winner of the Costa novel award as well as being a Guardian and Times Literary Supplement book of the year (among many other awards). We're reading it to continue our annual tradition of reading award winning books to see how our views compare. It's bound to provoke quite a discussion.

In August we will be talking about The Tattooist of Auschwitz by Heather Morris, which is a moving book based on the Holocaust. This widely acclaimed novel is based on the true story of Lale Sokolov, how he not only survived his years at Auschwitz-Birkenau, but also found love in the camp. The August meeting will be held on August 8th.

Kingsley Bookworms meet on the second Thursday of each month and everyone is welcome to join us at any of our meetings or events. There is no need to commit to coming to every meeting. We aim to be friendly and welcoming to one and all. Meetings start at 7.30pm and are held at the Hurst Chapel. ## Kingsley Walking Group – June 2019

June wasn't kind to the walking group. The long walk, scheduled to visit Moel Arthur in the Clwyds, had to be postponed because of torrential rain. We're sure to visit there again in the future. The short walk started in Thornton Hough and was well supported, including a (very) junior member aged 7. The weather was cloudy but cool and, fortunately, we missed the rain. We enjoyed walking in the area and the pub meal was excellent.



The July long walk will start from Little Moreton Hall. It's planned to be 8.5 miles long, including a ridge walk leading to Mow Cop. In August our walking dates are August 13th for the Long Walk and August 28th for the Short Walk.

Kingsley Walking group is an informal walking group which has been meeting for several years. Our monthly long walks usually start about 90 minutes drive away from Kingsley. Generally the long walks would be classified as "moderate" and the short walks are leisurely. We have a leader for every walk who checks the walk for stiles, distance, closed paths etc. New members and walk leaders are very welcome.


