Kingsley Players Commemorate First World War



The centenary of the start of World War One will be marked by Kingsley Players with a special supper and cabaret performance featuring songs, poems and sketches inspired by the hit show *Oh What a Lovely War*.

The Players will be onstage at Kingsley Community Centre for two nights only on Thursday 11th and Friday 12th September 2014. The evening starts with a two course hotpot supper (Cowards hotpot) at 7.30pm, followed by the performance.

This version of the show was first put together by the creative director Lynn Pegler to mark the end of the Weaver Words Literature Festival in Frodsham in April. It incorporates some of the best-loved First World War poems into a fast-paced one act production, featuring sketches, readings and all the favourite songs of the period.

Lynn explains: "This exciting mix of words and music serves up humour and pathos in equal measure. I'm delighted to say it went down at a storm at the literature festival so we are very pleased to reprise the performance, with a few extras, in Kingsley.

"Up and down the country, towns and villages are marking the centenary of the First World War in dozens of different ways. This is our contribution to Kingsley's commemoration of those momentous events 100 years ago.

CARE FOR THE ELDERLY - KTI collaborates with Home Instead Senior Care, a Frodsham based company, to provide care (personal, home help and companionship) to elderly people. One of our joint objectives is to get older people to be socially active. This is Mrs M's story:

Mrs M is 82 years old and lives alone in Kingsley. Unfortunately, after falling and spending six weeks in hospital and having rehabilitation, Mrs M had become too scared to go out again. This loss of confidence also resulted in a loss of independence and subsequent isolation.

In April 2014, Home Instead Senior Care offered to support Mrs M back to the 'Tea, Laughter and Company' group (TLC) which is regularly held at the Horseshoe pub in Kingsley from 10am to 12pm every Wednesday. Mrs M was collected and accompanied to the group.

Although nervous the first week, Mrs M is now a regular attendee again at the TLC group. Attending the group means that she meets up with friends and she has become socially active again, thereby avoiding the numerous detrimental health conditions, caused by social isolation.

Tour of Britain Monday 8th September

After the boost to tourism in Yorkshire from the Tour de France will the forthcoming Tour of Britain do the same for Kingsley?

A party of the Kingsley Velo, (aged,) bike riders made it to Buttertubs to watch the Tour de France on one of the hardest climbs of day 1 and we can all thoroughly recommend it to anyone. (Also to Keighley on day2)

You can get a taste of what we mean on Monday 8th September, simply by ambling down to the centre of the village to watch as the pro tour event, passes through our community.

The riders will be climbing up Acton Lane, past the Hazel Pear on through Crowton and into Kingsley via Mill Lane. Passing through the village on and out past the St John's church, then via Middle Lane, Meeting House Lane then onwards via Riley Bank to Manley Rd, Manley, Mouldsworth, Chester etc eventually finishing in Llandudno.

The lead cars are due to enter Kingsley at 11.07, with the riders about 15 mins behind them. It will take them about 7 minutes from one end to the other, with Meeting House Lane rated as a 1 minute, section!

The total mileage that day is a mere 125, an average speed expectation of around 28 mph.


