The Tennis Open Morning was held at the Institute on 28 July. There has been a regular junior attendance every Saturday since and continued support from parents. The Institute's groundsmen and the parents have done a great job to improve the courts and we now have two courts available for use. Thanks to all involved!

We are currently concentrating on tennis for Juniors – we have 32 children (from age 4 to 14) on our list. We are in contact with an LTA-Qualified and Licensed Coach with a view to organising regular coaching lessons for the children. If you are interested in enrolling your child/children for lessons (the next Laura Robson or Andy Murray?), please let me know either by telephone or by email (details below).

The cost for each child attending a group coaching session is likely to be around £3.50 for a one hour session and £6 for a two hour session. Junior Tennis Membership of the Institute is also required.

There has also been interest expressed about Senior tennis in the future at the Institute and it now seems sensible to set up a steering group of interested parties to consider the formal establishment of a Tennis Club at the Institute. 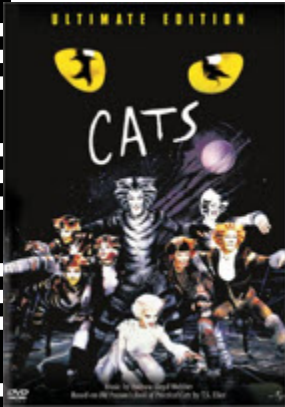

KINGSLEY WALKING GROUP

SHORT WALK - Wed 29 August 2012

Although the weather forecast was dismal, ten people turned up and parked at the Abbey Arms before taking a short bus ride to Delamere School. From the gates of the former Saighton Grange, built in 1410 and now home of Abbeygate College a path was taken to reach ' Waverton Approach ' one of the four former private access roads to Eaton Hall. Leaving the estate road, the route followed a minor road and track to reach the banks of the Shropshire Union Canal at Golden Nook bridge from where paths were taken westwards passing Abbeydale House and Waverton Gorse Wood to regain the canal towpath at Salmon's Bridge for the last mile back to the car park.
