What's Happening in the Forest

Our Ecology Team have been working alongside Cheshire Wildlife Trust to carry out this year's White-faced Darter surveys. There have been some encouraging numbers from several different mosses and seeing a female White-faced Darter ovipositing was a particular highlight. The surveys have finished for this year and fingers crossed for similar weather next year when they take place.

We have also had good numbers of Green Hairstreak Butterflies this year on some of the Bilberry areas of the Forest and are now looking forward to seeing how the White Letter Hairstreak are doing on the Elm trees.

Grass Snakes have also been seen in a couple of areas this year.

Our Sustainable Land Management team have recently had visits from students at the Scottish School of Forestry and Reaseheath College - both sets of students were learning about forestry work and roles within the sector.

Harvesting is scheduled to begin in Primrose Woods in July - there are some areas being thinned as part of the forest plan and also some areas being clear-felled due to disease.

Re-planting will take place later once the ground has been prepared following the harvesting operations.
